COURSE INTRODUCTION

The Higher Certificate in Interior Decorating educates students on how to enhance interior spaces. **Students develop design skills to create functional and meaningful environments.** Students apply **interior decorating, design, technology and materials knowledge to develop innovative design solutions.** This programme teaches students how to design captivating **spaces with a client's personal style in mind.** The Higher Certificate equips graduates **with practical knowledge and skills for entry into the job market,** with an emphasis on **work-integrated learning to prepare them for the professional world.**

The qualification can be completed as a **one-year full-time contact programme or via distance learning with flexible options (1-year min and 2-year max).** Graduates **may progress to a Diploma or Degree in Interior Design or another relevant design field.** Students pursuing further education must **meet institutional entrance requirements.**

COURSE OVERVIEW

- This practical, industry aligned programme equips students with the creative, technical, and business skills needed to thrive in the interior decorating industry.
- Students develop essential hand and digital drawing skills, along with a strong foundation in the theory, process, and principles of interior decorating.
- The course introduces spatial planning, surface treatments, colour theory, lighting, and materials, with a focus on real-world application and sustainable choices.
- Learners explore modern tools including AI, SketchUp, Homestyler, and Canva to visualise, style, and present professional interior schemes.
- Business modules include project and professional practice management, supplier relations, and how to start and run your own decorating business.
- Readiness modules help students prepare for life beyond the classroom – developing confidence, critical thinking, and the soft skills needed to thrive in work, society, and real-world challenges.
- Work-Integrated Learning (WIL) modules equip students for the professional world through CV preparation, interview practice, and real-world simulations that build career confidence and industry insight.

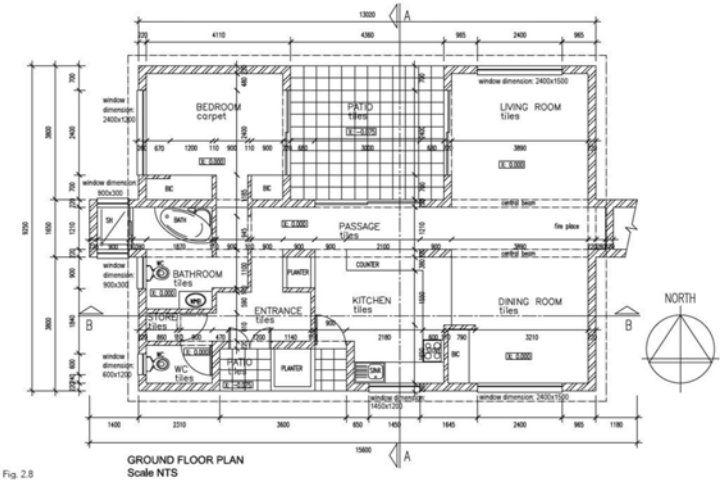
