They want an specialist who understands climate change and the issue surrounding being a 'green' company?

The **manufacturer of a product or fashion design company** or a company coming up with a new idea is looking to develop a greener, more environmentally sensitive product to get an edge on the market. They don't have the knowledge about green design, green materials, green technology.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- **Do I need a high school qualification?**

You will need to have a National Senior Certificate with admission to a Bachelor's Degree.

SACAP REGISTRATION

- **Am I going to be a Professional Architect? How does this differ from a university degree like a B.Sc Architecture?**

- This is NOT an architecture degree. You won't have the title Architect or Architectural Technologist.
- You will NOT learn all the mathematics and structural calculations required in architecture for buildings.
- You will work with architects, but may NOT sign off drawings and plans unless you register with SACAP.
- + You will be a SPECIALIST in eco and green design.
- + You will learn to calculate Green Star Ratings (a system used to measure how 'green' a building is).
- + You will be able to register with the GBCSA (Green Building Council South Africa).

- **Will I be able to register with SACAP (SA Council for the Architectural Profession)?**
YES

- After working for 2x years after graduation, register with SACAP as a 'Candidate Draughtsman.'
- After 3x Years as a 'Candidate Draughtsman,' you can become a 'Registered Draughtsman.'

INTERIOR DESIGN

Am I going to be an Interior Designer?

- - You can practice Interior Design with this degree.
- Your specialty is eco and green design - so you can be a good interior designer in that field.

How does this differ from our existing Interior Design degree?

- **INTERIOR DESIGN DEGREE**

- Focus is on conventional Interior Design and problem solving.
- Projects are specifically focused on Interior Design / Decorating.
- You learn design to solve Interior Design problems.

ENVIRONMENTAL DESIGN DEGREE

- Focus is mainly on Eco / Green design, materials, finishes and trends.
 - Projects focus on larger problems, covering eco / green solutions in the building industry - this includes the Built Environment, Interior Design and Urban Design.
 - You learn to calculate Green Star Ratings (measure how 'green' a building is)
- **Will I be able to register with the IID {African Institute for Interior Design}?**
Yes, you can register as an interior designer.

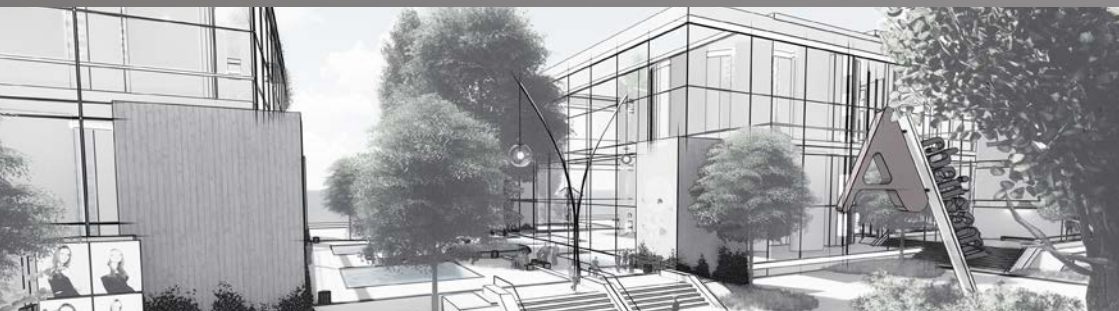
GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL
